Brief History of UB



Transylvanian bookman Gheorghe Lazăr establishes St Sava School, a Romanian teaching school.



Ruler Alexandru Ioan Cuza (1859–1866) establishes the University of Bucharest. The institution brings together the Faculties of Law, Sciences and Letters.

The Education Reform Act is enacted, and the Soviet Model of Higher Education is grafted. Consequently, the extensive reorganization of UB begins: the Faculties of Theology, Human Medicine and Veterinary Medicine are detached from the University. The University Institutes are abolished, and new Institutes subordinated to the Academy of Romanian's Popular Republic are created.

Advised by Constantin Cantacuzino, an illustrious humanist with studies in Padua, the Ruler of Wallachia, Constantin Brâncoveanu (1688–1714), founds in Bucharest the Princely Academy of St Sava. Courses are taught in Greek.

The fundamental stone of the University Palace is laid. Located in the University Square, the Palace was designed by Alexandru Orăscu, president of Romanian architects, following the model of Western Universities.

Competitiveness, Employability and International Recognition

In today's global society, where competition for human capital has become increasingly strong, the University of Bucharest is making notable efforts and steady progress in placing itself among the elite international universities, including through a visible presence in international charts and rankings.

In a progressively open world, beyond the need to respond quickly to local problems, a university which is connected to the realities of the moment must constantly adapt to both new regional and global challenges and to the constant competition encouraged by an increasingly globalized society.

UB is the only university in Romania present in the top QS – Employability 2020, with a position in the range of 301–500 worldwide, thus confirming the reputation it enjoys among employers. The list covers several key issues, such as student outcomes, partnerships with employers, connections between students and employers, and the employability rate of graduates.

The university of Bucharest ranks first nationally and in the range of 801–1000 worldwide in the QS World University Rankings 2020.

UB occupies the 42nd position in the international ranking QS – Emerging Europe and Central Asia University Ranking 2020.

Fields of Excellence at UB

In **Quacquarelli Symonds University Rankings**, in 2020, the University of Bucharest appears in 10 domains and subdomains out of the 53 analyzed:

In **World University Rankings by Subject**, UB is found in 4 fundamental fields out of the 5 fields analyzed: *Art and Humanities* and *Natural Science* (position 1 at national level), *Engineering & Technologies* and *Social Science & Management*;

UB is the only university in the country classified in the *English Language & Literature* and *Linguistics* subdomains;

UB is ranked first at national level for the subdomains *Chemistry* and *Physics & Astronomy*;

In 2020, for the first time, UB is included in **QS World University Rankings by Subject** with the subdomain *Computer Science (Computer Science & Information Systems)*.

In **Shanghai Global Ranking of Academic Subjects**, UB is present with the field *Earth Sciences*.

In the world ranking of universities after the impact on society according to the objectives of the UN – **Times Higher Education University Impact Rankings**, UB occupies the first position at national level, being best ranked at the objectives *Peace, justice and strong institutions*, *Reduced inequalities*, and *Gender equality*.

In the **URAP Field Based Ranking 2019/2020**, UB is present with 5 domains: *Mathematics*, *Physics*, *Geology* (first position at national level), *Earth Sciences* (the only university from Romania) and *Chemistry* (second position at national level).

In the ranking **Times Higher Education (THE)**, the University of Bucharest is ranked in 6 domains: *Art and Humanities*, *Business and Economics*, *Computer Science*, *Life Science*, *Physical Science*, and *Social Science*.

In **Round University Ranking**, UB occupies the first position at national level, being present in 5 of the 6 fundamental analyzed areas, and being ranked on the first position at national level in 3 of them: *Social Science*, *Natural Science*, *Life Science*.

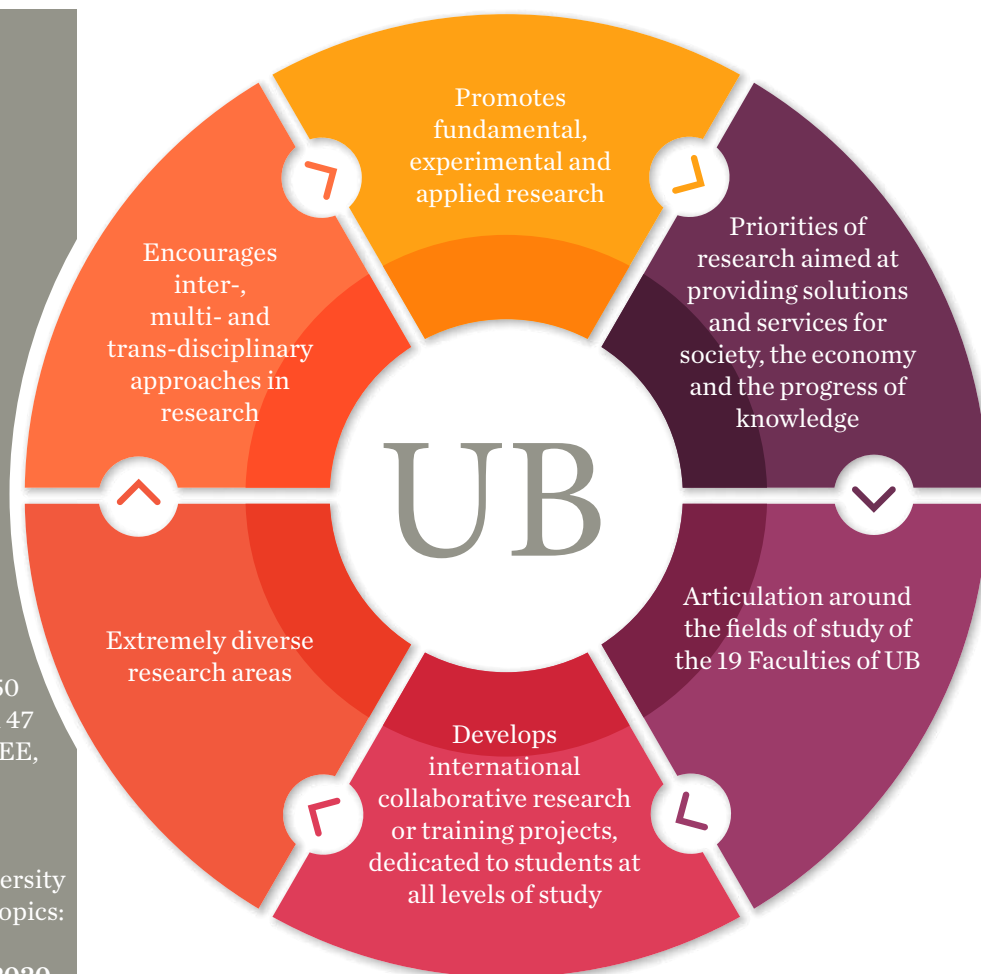
Excellence in Research

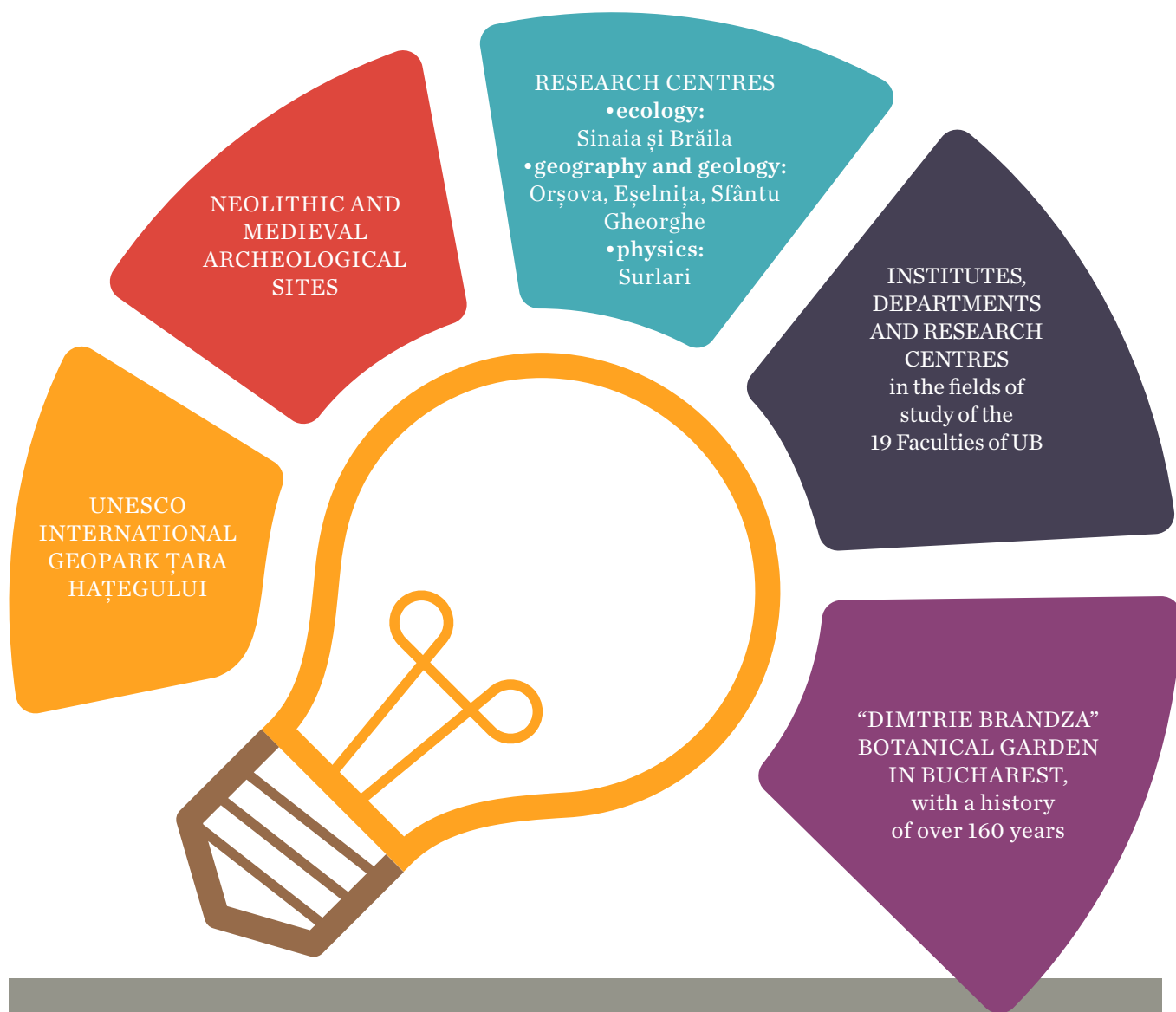

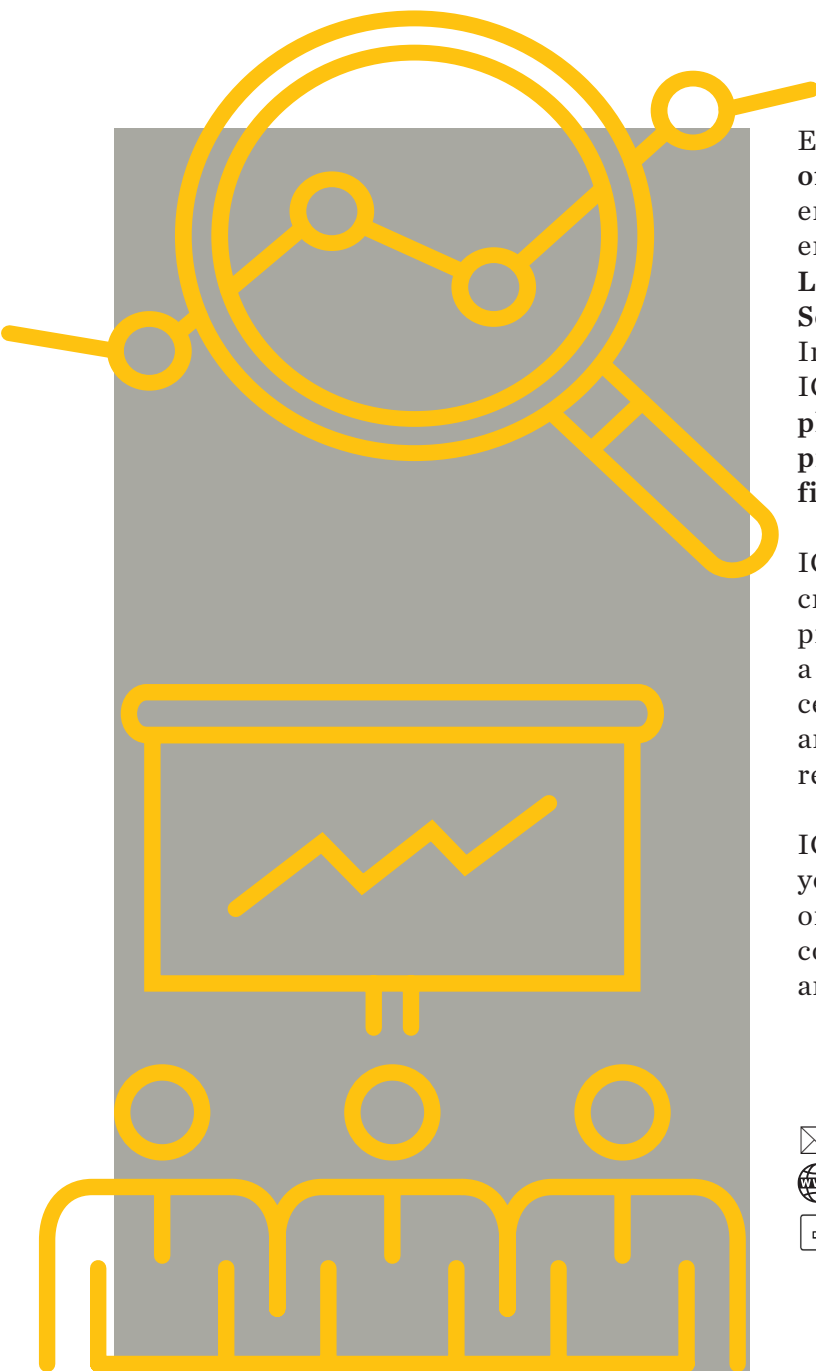

In 2019, UB researchers published over 1000 studies indexed in Clarivate Analytics (*Nature, Proceedings of the National Academy of Sciences of the United States of America*), of which over 30% were conducted in collaboration with researchers from more than 30 countries and over 50 books and chapters at prestigious international publishers (Oxford University Press, Springer, Wiley, Elsevier, etc.)

Research Institute of the University of Bucharest



Established in 2014, the **Research Institute of the University of Bucharest (ICUB)** was envisaged as an innovative structure, which encourages excellence and interdisciplinarity in **Life, Environment and Earth Sciences, Exact Sciences, Humanities and Social Sciences**. In addition to the 4 key areas of research, ICUB hosts the **institutional interdisciplinary platform for excellence in research, professional development, and training in the field of archeology – ArchaeoSciences**.

ICUB's mission is to provide a dynamic and creative environment for both young and professional researchers and to assert itself as a central point in the international research centres network, promoting the collaboration and the partnerships with other centres and research projects.

ICUB offers scholarship programs for both young and professional researchers and organizes various international scientific events: conferences and workshops, seminars, lectures and summer schools.

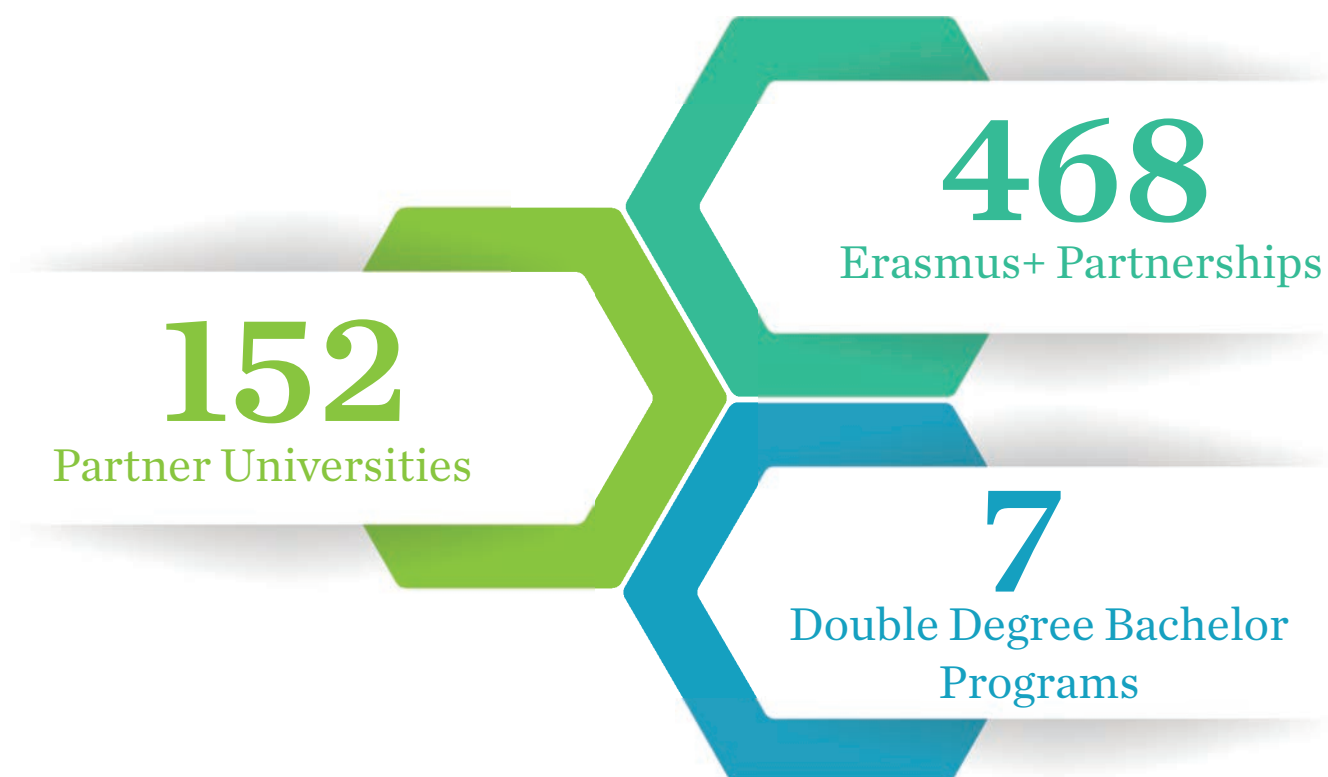
Humanities

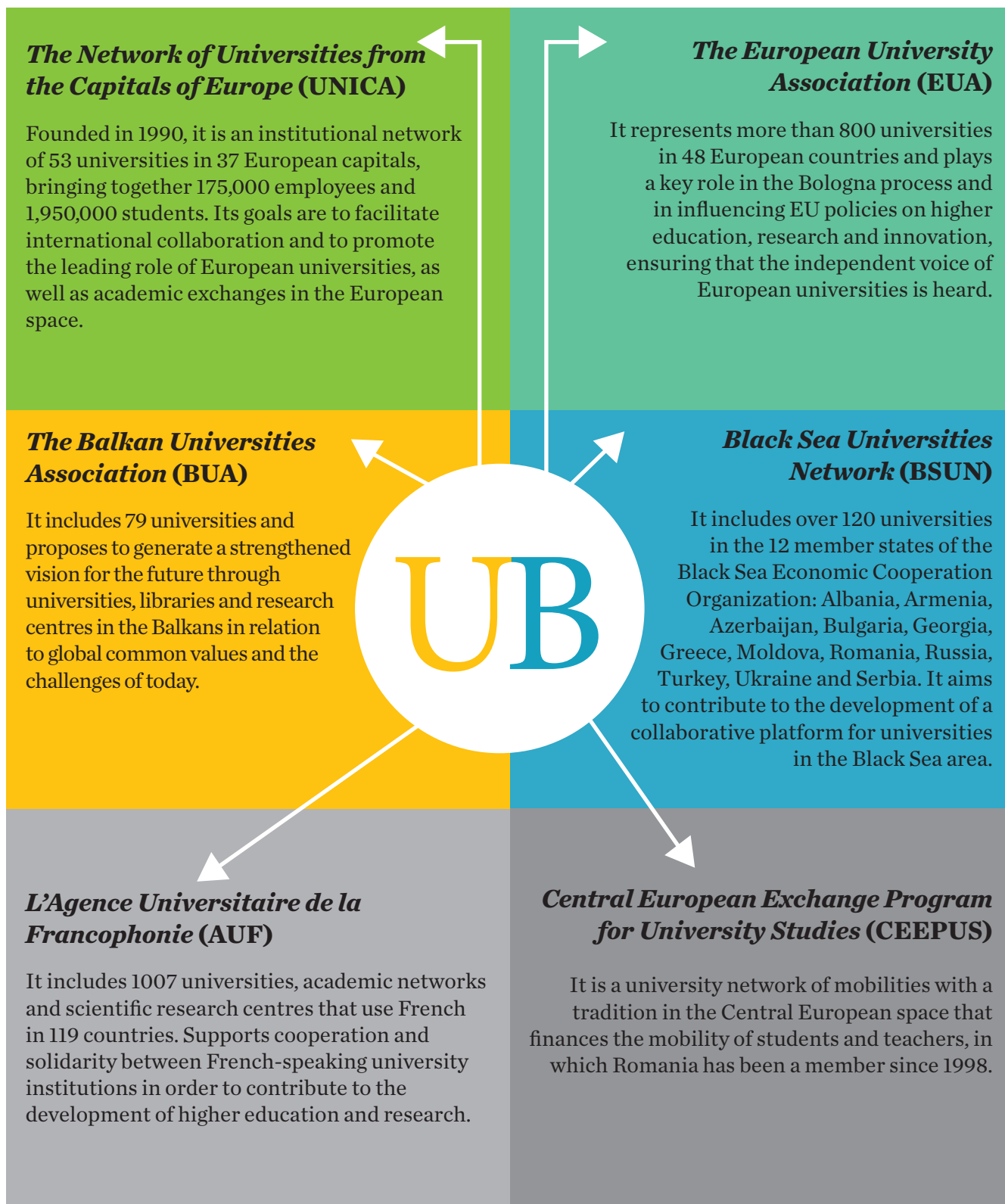

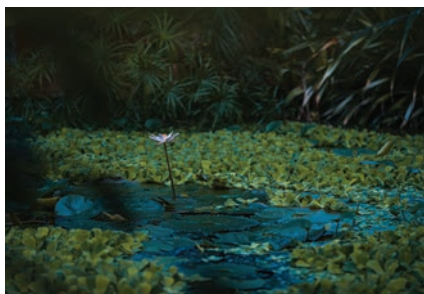

“Dimitrie Brandza” Botanical Garden

- with a living history that begins in 1860, it is an environment of active interaction and a space for knowledge and research. It covers an area of over 18 hectares.
- hosts over 3700 species of plants from various geographical and climatic areas and many rare plants.
- includes 10 outdoor sectors, organized thematically, a large and varied exhibition greenhouse, the old greenhouse and a fascinating botanical museum.
- The Botanical Garden Herbarium, established in 1882, currently includes a vast collection of over 500,000 plates.



- **The Botanical Museum** was added to the Botanical Garden in 1882 by the famous botanist Dimitrie Brândză.
- it is structured in 22 rooms, dedicated to the history of the Botanical Garden, medicinal plants, curiosities from the world of plants, special collections, etc.
- the first museum of this kind in which the zoning and layering of vegetation was applied in order to restore the unity of the living world. For even greater accuracy, the habitats thus constituted also include animals characteristic of the respective vegetation areas.
- the most important collection is the watercolors, made by Angiolina Santocono, with over 2500 works representing native and exotic plants.



- **The greenhouses of the Botanical Garden** are a study and research area, but also a recreation space in an exotic environment.
- include a rich selection of lush and unusual species from tropical, subtropical and equatorial areas around the globe.
- the exhibition-greenhouse, structured in eight compartments, includes over 1200 unique species.
- the old greenhouse, built between 1889 and 1891 after the model of the greenhouses in Liège, today includes a single visitable pavilion, intended for a collection of plants specific to tropical forests.



UNESCO International Geopark Țara Hațegului

The Geopark is an international program of continuous collaboration between the University of Bucharest and the partners from Țara Hațegului, in social, economic and cultural development projects. The Geopark expands the academic space of education, research and training in the real world.

- It is a member of the International Network of UNESCO Geoparks, the first territory in Romania with this status and the only geopark managed by a university.
- It is a model for other geopark projects, obtaining multiple awards, including the *Champion Model for Sustainable Development*, awarded by the Romanian Government.



- It includes 12 localities from Țara Hațegului, Hunedoara County, in the southwest of Transylvania.
- Scientific research is reflected in activities of interpretation and conservation of geological, natural and cultural heritage and in innovative projects in the field of education, geotourism and Creative Traditions.
- The Geopark unites the history of the Earth with the history of humans and invites visitors to a cultural and scientific adventure, a *Road through Time*, from the *Time of the First Rocks*, 600 million years ago, to the *Time of the Dinosaurs* and to *Our Time*.



- **Discover | Appreciate | Respect** is the invitation addressed to visitors for the development of responsible tourism. It is an approach supported by the 6 visiting routes, by the Geopark Houses, by the partnership for the Ecotourism Destination, by the cooperation in national and international programs.
- It promotes respect for local communities and supports social entrepreneurship and the circular economy.
- It develops a coherent program of involvement and continuous training of young people under the brand: *Geopark Volunteers* and *Geopark Ambassadors*.




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Museum of the University of Bucharest

- recomposes a history that descends in time to 1694, the moment when Constantin Brâncoveanu established the Princely Academy in Bucharest.
- established on July 29, 1967, the Museum includes over 2000 originals and facsimiles from the collection of the University and from donations received from professors and their descendants:

- documents
- manuscripts
- rare books
- university courses
- lithographs
- photographs
- plans
- medals
- plaques
- badges
- flags
- paintings
- sculptures
- inscriptions
- pieces of furniture

- the founding moment is marked in the Museum by the decrees of Alexandru Ioan Cuza on the establishment and functioning of UB, as well as by the fundamental stone of the old building of the University, which was put at the foundation of the building on October 10, 1857.
