GEP stage & total duration: January 2025 – December 2028. 2nd cycle currently in implementation.

What we have achieved/ worked on so far (February – August 2025)

- <u>Supported the launch of the postgraduate programme "Equal Opportunities Expert"</u> in collaboration with ANES October December 2025
- <u>Introduced parent-friendly format</u> for one national & one international conference organised by UB's Faculty of Sociology & Social Work – October 2025
- Created two tools for monitoring gender equality (for employees & students)
- <u>New structure & collaboration protocol for handling sexual harassment cases</u>, with one Vice-Rector directly overseeing gender equality
- Ongoing communication & dissemination; updated "Gender equality" page on UB's official website; created a dedicated page centralising gender-related PhD theses on GEP website
- <u>We are seeing the GEP's impact in the area of personnel training</u>, with new initiatives we have supported (e.g., new "Diversity Management" training taking place September October 2025).

GEP actions for the next period (until February 2026)

- Review & update the sexual harassment procedure this fall (working with the Ethics Committee, the Service for Inclusion & the Vice-Rector)
- Create & promote informational material on inclusive language
- Launch an online campaign for UB staff regarding existing facilities in national & institutional legislation
- Prepare & publish the first annual GEP implementation report

Challenges & lessons learnt

- Coordinating with multiple actors (Vice-Rector, Ethics Committee, Inclusion Service) for the sexual harassment procedure showed the need for clearer collaboration protocols & shared responsibilities.
- GEP initiatives have impacted UB's culture due to active promotion and continuous engagement & visibility.
- Participation in EU projects proved essential, offering tools and valuable peer learning.
- + UB ranked 3rd in the world for SDG "gender equality"!
